Maximum points you can miss: Up to 15 points If you score more than 15 points off, you fail. Critical errors also lead to automatic failure. Number of correct answers needed to pass DMV test: For learners under 18, you must answer 38 out of 46 questions correctly. Over 18s need to answer 30 out of 36 questions correctly. Learner's permit cost and requirements: A \$33 fee is required for a learner's permit. In addition, you'll take a standard vision test at your local DMV, and pass the written knowledge test. Number of attempts to pass driving test: You're allowed three attempts to pass the vehicle inspection test. To become a licensed driver in California, one must pass both the basic control skills test and the road test. The written driving test is challenging, with a study indicating that four out of ten people fail it on their first attempt. However, this might be due to inadequate studying rather than the test's difficulty. Massachusetts received a difficulty score of 77, while Washington ranked highest with an 80.
