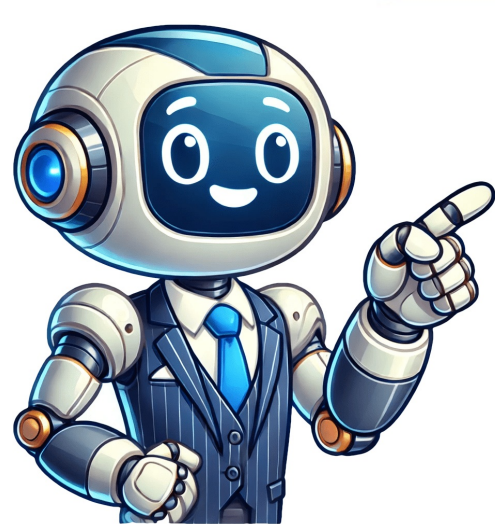

In addition, the 22nd Amendment to the Constitution limits the president to two terms in office, with the exception of a vice president who becomes president and serves more than two years of an unexpired term. Trump attended the Fordham University in Bronx for two years after which he joined the Wharton School of Business at the University of Pennsylvania. He was the Nobel Peace Prize awardee in 2009. He bagged 36 contests while his main rivals Ted Cruz, Marco Rubio and John Kasich won in just 11, 3 and 1 states respectively. Maine and Nebraska select electors based on who wins the popular vote in each congressional district and 2 electors are awarded based on the winner of the statewide popular vote. The electoral college consists of 538 members, which is equal to the number of members of Congress each state has plus 3 for the District of Columbia. This popular vote determines the makeup of the electoral college, which actually elects the president. (2) 25th Amendment: If the Vice President and majority of the Cabinet submit to Congress a written declaration that the President is unable to discharge the powers and duties of the office, the Vice President assumes the power and duties of the office as Acting President. However, on November 8, 2016, the Republican secured a surprise victory against Democrat Hillary Clinton, becoming the oldest and the wealthiest individual to become the president of the United States. The difference is due to the non-consecutive terms of Grover Cleveland and Donald Trump. The oath of office must also be taken before assuming the duties of the office. Shortest Presidency: William Henry Harrison served only 31 days in office before passing away. After graduating in 1968, he joined the company and by 1971, was in full control of the affairs of the company. There have been three presidents impeached, but none were convicted and removed from office. Trump focused on domestic issues such as offshoring American jobs, where he promised to bring back jobs to the US from China and Mexico; illegal immigration, Islamic terrorism and US national debt.
