He left the USWA in the spring of 1990. World Wrestling Federation (1990A 1991) Runnels debuted as a fan favorite at the World Wrestling Federation (WWF) at the end of 1990, fighting as how Rhodes. His first game on WWF (now WWE) was against Paul Diamond on September 21, 1990. [13] In December 1990, Rhodes defeated Debia Ted in a televised challenge of ten minutes. On January 19, 1991, at the Royal Rumble, Rhodes and his dusty father lost to Ted Dibiasase and Virgil in a fight on the tag team, and both left immediately later. [14] Return to WCW Joining with Barry Windham (1991 - 1992) In February 1991, Runnels joined the World Championship Wrestling (WCW), Wrestling as "the Natural" Dustin Rhodes. He counted on Larry Zbyszko until April 1991, when he refused to join the York Foundation of Alexandra York, beginning a hief with Terrence Taylor foundation. At the end of 1991, the Rhodes formed a tag team with Barry Windham and began to chase the WCW Tag Team Champions the Enforcers (Arn Anderson and Zbyszko). The pair received a title in Clash of the Champions XVII, but Windham was injured before the event. A Ricky Return Barboat was chosen for the Rhodes partner, and the improvised duo won the Championship WCW World Tag Team Team. They lost their belts on January 16, 1992, for Arn Anderson and a dangerous member of the Alian  Bobby Eaton. In an engraved edition of WCW Saturday at night on September 2, 1992, Rhodes joined Windham to defeat Steve Williams and Terry Gordy for the Unified Championship WCW World Tag Team and NWA World Tag Championship (his Nwa title reign is not recognized by NWA); The match would air on October 3 3. They would hold their belts for about two months before we lost them to Steamboat and Shane Douglas in a memorable match on the edition of November 18, Clash of the Champions XXI. Windham turned Rhodes after departure when Rhodes refused to align the steamboat after an accidental low blow. US heavyweight champion (1993 - 1995) In January 1993, Rhodes reached the final of a tournament to decide the number one for the United States Heavyweight WCW Championship. Rhodes lost the title to Steve Austin in two out of three falls depart on the Starrcade, after losing both falls. In March From 1994, Rhodes began to play with Bunkhouse Buck and Col. Robert Parker. After Parker introduced Arn Anderson and Terry Funk as adversaries for Runnels, Runnels replied bringing his father, a former funk enemy, back to the ring for the team again against the stain of Parker's stallion. In December 1994, Parker introduced Ziu another adversary for Rhodes, the Blacktop Valentine. In the non-censored pay-per-view on March 19, Rhodes lost to the Blacktop feed on the unique king of the company's history. The game, which was filmed several days earlier, resulted in both rhodes and blacktop churro being fired from the company, as the two had chipped during the departure after being instructed for each other, which was against Corporate Policy on the Poca at WCW. [14] Go back to WWF Premiere of Goldust (1995) Goldust in 1995 in August 1995, Runnels returned to WWF, Wrestling as a village Goldust, dubbed "the bizarre" because of his scary, scary, and sexually suggestive mannerisms and presence. Using psychology in the ring for your advantage, Goldust then used lascivious and, during mental games Anger, confuse and distract your opponents. He used Tactic as groping and excessive affection toward his opponents in the indst of delivering his attacks. For this purpose, one of Goldust's marks was his exaggerated inhalation, suggestively painting, while caressing his own body; This all exhales it through a vicious biting sound in your adversary, destined to start. The character was portrayed as a queen drag obsessed with the films and all gold, which is a parade of the Oscar figurine. Under the decoy, Runnels wore a predominantly gold (with bocadinhos of other colors, such as white and black); Black and face gold paint; And during entrances and promos, a gleaming gold tonic and a blonde vif of platinum over her plated blond hair. Years later, Runnels said Vince McMahon called and offered him the Gimmick and mentioned "Andri gino" several times; Runnels, who want a separate identity from his father on it, promptly accepted without knowing what the word "Andriety" meant, then, promptly looked up at the dictionary after descending from the phone with McMahon and shocked to see What did it mean to himself "What do I get into?" [15] Runnels Properly admitted that the first months of the Gimmick were uncomfortable for him, for they did not find his personality at all, but decided to work with what was given to him and "run with him." [15] Goldust won his striver departure on October 22, 1995, against Marty Jannetty at In Your House 4 pay-per-view. He defeated Bam Bam Bigelow on the last Bigelow WWF game at Survivor Series. [1] Then he rivealed with Ramon, whom he persecuted and sent messages for the end of 1995. The dispute culminated at the Royal Rumble on January 21, 1996, where Goldust defeated Ramon to the Intercontinental Championship due to Interference of 1A 2 , Kid 3. This game also marked the striver of Valet de Goldust, Marlena, interpreted by his wife, then Terri. With his seductive, coldly indifferent and mysterious character, Marlena complemented Goldust. Her trick consisted of sitting in the ring in a director chair during the Goldust matches, advising him while smoking large brown cigars. A reunion between Goldust and Ramon on Wrestlemania XII was canceled after Ramon was suspended, with Goldust instead fight Roddy Piper on a hollywood rise backon, [16] At the end of the fight, Piper stripped Goldust of his ring costume reveal wearing female lingerie; Runnels revealed in 2018 (when making jokes in his own tail) that was only three days before wrestlemania xii to use a slip and thong under his ring costume and have piper strip it down, receiving the approval McMahon's level. [15] Goldust defended his intercontinental championship in attacks against Savio Vega and The Ultimate Warrior before losing to Ahmed Johnson at King of the Ring on June 23, 1996. In August 1996, Goldust briefly won control over humanity and rivealed With The Undertaker. His attention soon turned into Marc Mero and his wife Sable. Goldust and Marlena tried to get Sable to integrate his team, but Mero won the dispute and kept by his side. He also had a ladder game with Shawn Michaels on the Internet Pay-Per-View (PPV) XPERIENCE by WWF Championship, but lost the match. In December 1996, Goldust entered a fight with Hunter Hearst Helmsley, when Helmsley began to flirt with Goldust valet: Marlena. This dispute took Chyna's debut as a new helmsley bodyguard, which would mistreat Marlena and cause sympathy for Marlena & Goldust. This was the first time Goldust transformed into a fan favorite, instead of the village character he was before. Various tricks (1997a In May 1997, Goldust revealed his identity as Dustin Runnels, the son of Dusty Rhodes. In the summer and autumn of this He joined other fighters in his conflict with Hart Foundation, fighting in particular with Brian Pillman. Goldust defeated Pillman at the Summerslam in which Pillman was forced to wear a dress for a month, so Pillman challenged Goldust again for a match at Ground Zero: In his house, Goldust agreed to get lost, would lose Marlena to Pillman for 30 Days, Goldust lost the game to Pillman and was forced to lose Marlena, had Goldust Won, Pillman would leave WWF. Shortly before the thirty days went up, Pillman died of heart disease before the Badd Blood on 5 October 1997. In November 1997, Goldust Split with Marlena and refused to cooperate with his teammates survivor Series, who once again turned him into a jump. This led to a fight with Vader in December 1997 and the appearance of the artist previously known as Goldust (a reference to Prince), managed by Luna Vagron. He began to imitate celebrities and fellow fighters with characters such as "Chynadust", "DustyDust", "Dustydust", "Hunterdust", "Flashdust", "Marilyn Mansondust", "Sabledust", and "Vaderdust" 1998. [14] Around this time, he made a legitimate effort of management to get the money implants as part of the decoy before being spoken out of it by McMahon. [17] In June 1998, Goldust rivealed Val Venis, who had been involved with Terry during his separation. Now passing by his real name, Runnels began to speak out (especially in recorded vignettes) in the increasingly nervous WWF product and promote alternatives to watch the show as read the Bible. These vignettes were sponsored by the fictional group, "evangelists against television, films and entertainment," the acronym where if "EATIME" is e veiled joke from WWF, [18] Runnels a new born Christian declared, alluding to his "his" return, and walk in the middle of the crowd with posters saying "He's coming back!" As the return of Christ was clearly implicut, Runnels was indeed reference to the return of Goldust Trick, which he repeated in October 1998 against Sean Morley and then in November 1998, he began feuding with Jeff Jarrett about the attention of your manager, Debra. At the beginning of 1999, Goldust rivealed with Al Snow, after stealing the Head mannequin, snow mascot, and the blue Meanie, which recently renamed "bledust" and adopted many of Goldust mannerisms. Then Goldust defeated Meanie at the Massacre of Valentine's Day, Meanie became a Goldust apprentice. After Ryan Shamrock became the servant of Goldust, Meanie and Shamrock began by disputing Goldust's attention. In the same period of time, Goldust won the Intercontinental Championship again from the Dogg road and then lost to The Godfather two weeks later. He would join the Blue Meanie to have some matches against Hardy Boyz until Goldust left the company in June 1999. Second Return to WCW Seven and "The American Nightmare" (1999A 2001) Runnels returned to World Championship Wrestling On November 8, 1999 edition of WCW Monday Nitro, filming several vignettes for a fantastic character, painted-face with the name Seven. These vignettes contained rhodes sinister scenes in the complete composition outside the window of a child's room. The trick was reported to have been based on "The Strangers" of the 1998 Noir Dark City movie. The character was abandoned after Turner standards and practices expressed concern that this artifice could be interpreted as a child's kidnapper. When returning to the WCW television, Rhodes took off the costume and handed a worked shot in which he mocked unrealistic tricks as well as his time as Goldust at WWF. After turning the heel on his return, Runnels began to fight as "The American Nightmar" like Dusty Rhodes Jr., working three dates at the beginning of April, all simple games and all victories. In July, Runnels returned to the United States and appeared for Full Impact Pro, tag partnership with Barry Windham and defeat the killer and Ryze Cuban. Runnels did not appear on the independent circuit for the rest of 2004 and much of 2005, until the first wrestlerrunion, in partnership with his father and Mike Graham against Abdullah The Butcher, Kevin Sullivan, and CM Punk. After his exit of TNA, he made some appearances with Dusty for CCW against Phi Delta Slam. Runnels also competed in Tribute to Starrcade program on November 19 in a match against Terry Funk, which ended in one in Contest. Total Nonstop Action Wrestling (2004a 2005) on February 4, 2004, he debuted in Total Nonstop Action Wrestling (TNA) as "The Lone Star" Dustin Rhodes and could not beat Jeff Jarrett by the NWA World Heavyweight Championship. On February 18, Runnels and El Leon defeated Kevin Northcutt and Legend in a Tag Team fight. In December 2004, he returned to TNA, once again fighting as Dustin Rhodes. On January 7, 2005, an impact episode, Rhodes and Jeff Hardy defeated Kash and Dallas. On January 14 impact episode, Rhodes defeated Chris Candido. At the end resolution, Rhodes defeated Kid Kash. On February 11 Episode of Impact Wrestling, Rhodes and AMA   rica Most Wanted defeated Kid Kash, Dallas and Raven in a Tag Team Combat of six men. At the Against All Odds, Rhodes lost to Crow, but has return on Destination X, when he defeated Corvo in a bullrope match. He then entered a rivalry with Bobby Roode and Lockdown, Rhodes defeated Roode in 2 of 3 Cai prince of the dark cage game. His TNA contract expired in April 2005 and he chose not to renew it, leaving TNA. Third Return to WWE (2005A 2006) Runnels returned to World Wrestling Entertainment on October 31, 2005, like a heel and back under the Goldust costume, as Jonathan Coachman listed and Vader to attack Batista. [2] Goldust and Vader unsuccessfully interfered in a Street Fight between Batista and Coachman, on behalf of Coachman at Taboo Tuesday. [2] After the event, Goldust again disappeared from the television. In January 2006, Goldust participated in the Royal Rumble and was assigned once to the Raw brand, until he was released from his WWE contract on June 14, 2006, to NO-showing an appearance. [20] Runnels made a brief appearance in Wrestlemania 22 to give Booker T advice on his departure against The Boogeyman where he insinuated that the only way he could beat The Boogeyman went to put worms on his    . [21] Independent circuit (2006a 2007) After returning to his fourth season with WWE, Runnels, once again disappeared from the indies, but made a special appearance with Jerry Lawler's Wrestling Memphis on 3 Mar 2006, like Goldust, in a match against Lawler, which he lost after Lawler hit him with a stream of action. Runnels was released from his fourth season with WWE on June 14 two weeks and six days later, on July 1st, he returned to World-1, defeating Tully Blanchard at the main event. On October 14, he appeared with the UK promoting a wrestling pro, under the name of Dustin gold (the name he would use in AJPW) with a victory over curry man. Asking by AJPW in 2007, Runnels The rivalry with Phi Delta Slam returned, especially in Tag team matches with a variety of partners, including KIP James. In mid-2007, he made several appearances with the UWF promotion of Hermie Sadler for the advertising campaign his return to TNA, making his estrangement on 2 March with a victory on Steve Corino. He appeared with UWF in all his Mandate with TNA, facing the tastes of Scott Steiner, Sabu, David Flair, Andrew Martin, and D'Lo Brown. Your mandate at UWF also saw compete in the often considered "cross-promotional" "cross-promotional" Games game against the JBL team (JBL's management, which signed a contract with WWE as a commentator at the Poca) was constituted by Steve Corino, C. W. Anderson, the American Xchange Latin, and Elix Skipper. Runnels was a member of SGT. From the slaughter staff slaughter, along with the sisters of Steiner and the Mack's sisters. Team Slaughter won the fight. Final appearance Runnels with UWF was on September 22, 2007, where he and Abyss were losing at the end of a Tag Team fight against D'Lo Brown and a local football coach. Return to Japan (2007) on January 28, 2007, was announced that Rhodes would appear on February 17, 2007, All Japan Pro Wrestling Rya Goku Kokugikan Show in Tocio. On February 15, Rhodes, identified as gold Dustin, appeared in the ring during a match involving the great muta, resulting in a fight between Rhodes and the great muta. [2] On February 17, Rhodes and Jinsi Shinzaki were defeated by the Great Muta and Yoshihiro Tajiri in a Tag Team attack. [2] Return to TNA (2007A 2008) on July 15, 2007, Rhodes returned the total nonstop Action Wrestling at Victory Road and lined up with Christian Cage, helping him defeat "Wildcat" Chris Harris. [2] In an interview at TNA Impact! Driven by Mike Tenay, Rhodes discussed accusations to have a divided personality and stated that he was going to hug him and leave him out. TNA presented the interview as an emotional collapse on the part of Rhodes. On August 12, at Hard Justice, Rhodes debated his new ring name, Black Reign, and a "new, darker and bizarre look." On hard justice, Harris defeated Black Reign for disqualification when Black Reign attacked several logs. [2] The following week, the trick was explored even further, saying that Rhodes constantly alternate between Rhodes and Black Reign. [22] He was highlighted at Bound for Glory at stake the ball of a monster against Rhino, Abyss and Raven, which he lost. [2] Black Reign challenged Abyss to a "horror shop" game in genesis and lost. In genesis, the new partner of Black Reign, RELLIK (which is "Killer" spelled to the contrary), made his estrangement after attacking Abyss. [2] At Turning Point, Abyss and Raven defeated Black Reign and Rellik in a 10,000 tacks game. [2] Originally, this game was signed to be Abyss and Rhino against RELLIK and Black Reign, but due to an injury, Rhino was replaced by Raven for this game. In the impact!, He helped RELLIK beat Kaz. [2] Later, the same night, he appeared for an interview, like Dustin Rhodes, without his Black Reign Make-up and said his "Alter Ego" was frightening him since he was child. His interview was interrupted by the furious Kaz. [2] This led to a combat between the two in the final resolution, where Kaz won. Reinado and his partner Rellik then began to rival Eric Young and his new Super Eric Superhero Gimmick. [2] In Destination X, Black Reign and Rellik faced Eric Young and Kaz in a loser effort. In the chopped plane, Black Reign and Rellik competed in a Six team cufted in the match cage that was gained by Kaz and Super Eric. After three months of not appearing on the television, Black Reign's profile was removed from TNA Roster page and he was released from his TNA contract. [23] Independent circuit (2008) After his release of TNA at the beginning of 2008, Runnels briefly returned to the Wrestling Coastal Championship to face the members of Phi Delta Slam (Bruno Sassi and Big Tilly) before starting his WWE Fifth Season in October 2008.
