Frankfurt Airport is one of the busiest airports in Europe and an important connecting hub for traffic passing through the continent. The airport also serves as the main hub for major operator Lufthansa. Frankfurt Airport - terminal and gate map At Frankfurt Airport you find two large passenger terminals, conveniently called Terminal 1 and Terminal 2. In the map at the top of the page you find the location of each terminal and the gates. There is also a smaller terminal that is dedicated to first class flights. Terminal 1: This terminal is the older and larger of the two main terminals at the airport. The terminal is divided into several floors with the arrivals at ground floor and departures at the upper floor. In total you find more than 100 gates in Terminal 1. The primary users of this terminal are Lufthansa and its Star Alliance partners. Terminal 2: With a little more than 40 gates, Terminal 2 is mainly used by the members of Oneworld. This is also where you find the airlines that are not part of any global airline alliance, like for example Emirates. When it comes to hotels at the airport there are actually a number of different options to choose from, located at different parts of the airport. With that being said, the majority of the hotels are found close to Terminal 2. If you're transferring between terminals, the SkyLine people mover is an efficient option, with stations strategically located throughout the terminals, ensuring quick and convenient transfers.Here are some tips to help you move around the airport smoothly:Use the SkyLine: This train connects both terminals, with frequent services every 2-3 minutes. Note that it has separate cars for Schengen and non-Schengen passengers, so make sure you board the correct one depending on your destination within the airport.Check terminal assignments: Terminal 1 primarily serves Lufthansa and Star Alliance flights, while Terminal 2 caters to oneworld and SkyTeam airlines, among others.
