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So, if you're new to writing, this could be a better option. Strunk & White Thin style elements (about 100 pages) and yet quite complete, this book remains a long-time favorite of writing students. However, it is not an easy reading for beginners and every time you read it, you will discover a few new lessons on writing. If you take this, read at least 2-3 times. I went through this book about 8-10 times, and every time I learned something new. All the writings of Ann Handley This book covers how to write for the web, which has its nuances. On the writing of the well of William Zinsser This book is more for professional writers, but also a beginner can earn few useful tips from the book. 4. Books about talking I crossed the number of books on howwell English, and are woefully short on foundations and insights on most components to talk. They focus strongly onand shape phrases for common situations (such as healthy, as speaking on the phone, how to make a sales call, and so on.) some also focus on vocabulary and pronunciation. common situations can serve a purpose for absolute beginners, but not so much for others. Besides, how many situations can be covered in a book and how many can they remember? to add a layer, more often than not, you will not find a situation that takes place exactly the way you read in the book. a real conversation on any topic, say time, can go in millions of directions. in the same vein, pronunciation is difficult to learn through the phonetic form as mentioned in most books. much better is the non-phonc form. here is an example so that we can understand this. try to pronounce the following two: Source: phonetic form and non-phonc form if you are like most, you fight with the first (phonetic) because of its alien symbols. the second (non phonetic) is much more intuitive, but is missing from most books. (you may have understood – especially from the non-phonc form – that the word in question is ‘refrigerator’). better yet is listening to pronunciation. This is the way most of us have learned pronunciation – listening to others or directly to the pronunciation of words on google. on vocabulary, the book, instead of listing only words, their meaning, and few phrases of example, can talk about tactics to learn vocabulary that you can actually go into speech and keep it for a long time. can also talk about how people who stop a lot for the desire for good vocabulary (know the word in their native language, but not in English) can build their basic vocabulary fast. book can prescribe 1-2 (you don't need more) exercises you can practice anywhere, at any time to identify gaps in yourand consolidate existing vocabulary. And the mistakes to avoid? People spend months and years in futile looking for things that don't work. I know people who adopt watching moviesread newspapers as the main tools to get better to speak English. To sum up this part, a book about talking should explain tactics that people can use to learn by themselves. In other words, instead of selling one hundred types of fish to someone, he teaches them how to catch fish. They will get all the variety by themselves. Give people basics, insights (and not only lists) about how to learn different English spoken components. And how to avoid common mistakes. Before closing this section, I must emphasize that you get better to talk through more talk. A book can only support. At the fundamental level, speaking requires your vocal organs (slide, tongue and throat) to get used to producing sounds in a certain rhythm (pause, intonation, rhythm etc.) that can come mainly through speaking. 5. Books about pronunciation There are many books on pronunciation, but, as mentioned in the previous section, the pronunciation of learning from books is an inefficient way. The best way to learn pronunciation is to listen (and not read) pronunciation. But, unfortunately, books do not speak. dictionaries online, however, do. Listen to the pronunciation on online dictionaries to improve your pronunciation efficiently. You do not need a book for it. Two dictionaries online for pronunciation that I recommend to you are: Dictionary.com ( Provides pronunciation in non-phonc form, which is much more intuitive than the phonetic form.) Cambridge 6 English Dictionary. Vocabulary Books Good vocabulary will help your English written and spoken both. But, do you need a book on the topic to improve your vocabulary? Do you need a Norman Lewis? You don't. You do not need a book on vocabulary apart perhaps the specific case of preparation for an exam. Esha Marwani has improved his vocabulary organically by reading a lot of books and novels that fit on his level for a period ofWatch your conversation on your journey to improve English language skills in this TEDx talk (duration: 1:45 1:45)He immersed himself in the books, and for a period of time ‘some voice in his head began to form grammatically correct phrases’, began to hate words in the right context even if you did not know their meaning (i.e. building vocabulary unconsciously.) its method is absolutely excellent, but if you are motivated, you can make your vocabulary-construction many times more efficient. during reading, mark the words whose meaning or use is not sure and, after finishing reading, refer to a dictionary, go beyond the meaning of the word if you want to make your vocabulary usable in speech and writing, also seeks the phrases of example (in a dictionary) that follow the meaning. This method is much more sustainable and the network (keep your vocabulary for a long time) than going through the word lists. here you build vocabulary at a constant pace, learning through context (of the book you are reading.) said this, I looked at the following four vocabulary books to understand their effectiveness in the construction of vocabulary that you can use in speech and writing: word power made easy by norman lewis 30 days for more powerful vocabulary of wilfred funk and norman lewis all on words of maxwell numberg and morris rosenblum how to build a better vocabulary of maxwell Nuremberg and morris rosenblum make a nice job of categorizing words under a central idea like types of personality, doctors, science, word habits and compliments, which is an ideal way to learn words and also have extensive exercises in each chapter to practice the vocabulary you are learning. However, I think that these books do not have a few points: learning how a word is used through example phrases is an important cog in the construction of vocabulary. These vocabulary books do not have enough examples.pronunciation is mentioned in phonetic symbols, which is less intuitive than non-phonc form. (We have seen the example of the word ‘refrigerator’ before in the post.) Also, when it comes to pronunciation, all booksfrom the lack of option to hear pronunciation (for obvious reasons,) something that can be realized on an online dictionary through only the click of a button. They go too deep into unsolicited things such as the origin and dissection (prefix, root and suffix) of the word. Few are interested in exploring a word like that, and therefore this information distracts the reader and unnecessarily loads the chapters. The significant proportion of words in these books is rare and difficult and should be avoided in verbal or written communication. (Some people mistakenly believe that falling into difficult words in their speech and writing will make them look smart.) A few examples from Word Power Made Easy: ambivert, misanthrope, misogamist, psychogenic, omniscience, male diction, maladroito, martinet and voluble.
