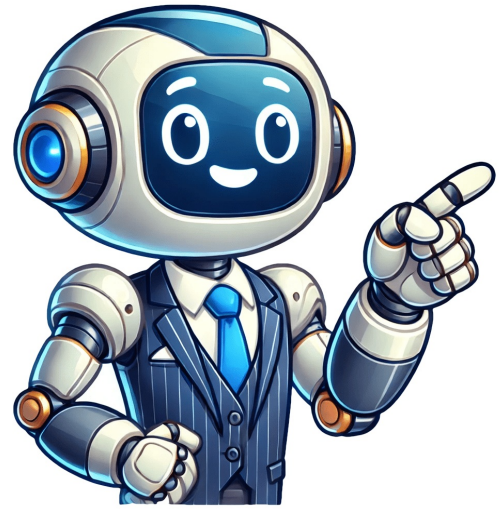

## Delaware military academy

Delaware Military Academy offers dual-enrollment classes through Delaware Technical and Community College, earning a "Superior" ranking for high scores on standardized testing and being named a Blue Ribbon School in 2019. The school had previously lacked sufficient athletics facilities, relying on nearby Banning Park and other high schools' facilities. In 2015, DMA purchased additional land to build a third building, announcing its plans for a gymnasium (the "drill deck") in 2016. The Anthony N. Fusco, Sr. Athletic & Academic Center opened in 2017, followed by the \$2.5 million turf stadium, Fusco Memorial Field, in 2019. In 2010, the ice hockey team became the first DMA team to go undefeated and won the school's first championship. The school also has a strong football program, with Patrick Clark being one notable player. ##### Looking back at what our peers have said about us, we see that many feel safe and happy here. A total of 34 students agreed on these points. Some even enjoy events like Spirit Weeks or watching sports teams compete in lacrosse. While the facilities may be modest, the staff's resourcefulness and dedication have ensured that we make the most of our resources. With a student population of 567, Delaware Military Academy remains committed to providing an exceptional education. Notably, the school has received several awards, including the Blue Ribbon School designation in 2019. The faculty consists of 34 experienced teachers who have grown by 30% over the past five years. The school offers grades 9-12, with no virtual instruction, and has maintained a strong student-teacher ratio of 17:1. Academically, Delaware Military Academy consistently performs well in various subjects. In math, 92% of students are proficient, while reading and language arts show 62% proficiency, with science scores slightly lower at 21%. The school's dedication to education is evident in its rigorous curriculum and commitment to academic excellence.
