View, organize, and share photos and videos with iCloud Photos on the web. /> /> When you set up Photos in iCloud for Windows, you can see photos and videos stored in iCloud Photos directly on your computer. Note: The above method is applicable to Windows 11 users. Click the "Download" button at the top right corner. Like iPhone or iPad, you need to enable iCloud Photos to access iCloud Photos on your Mac device. Repeat that process for every device you want to sync with iCloud. In our case, we copied the photos to the desktop. Now, wait till all your iCloud Photos appear in your Mac's Photos app, as photos may take some time to load depending on your internet speed. You can also access photos on the iCloud website by logging in with Apple ID and clicking Photos. In your desktop or mobile browser, you can now view and download all your iCloud photos taken on your iPhone or iPad. Tap Photos. You should see all the photos taken on either your iPhone or iPad and stored on iCloud. Select "iCloud Photos" on the next pop-up window, and click "Done." 4. If a photo or video is edited or deleted on an Apple device or on iCloud.com, the changes appear here automatically.Note: If you're using an iCloud Shared Photo Library on your Apple device, changes to your photos or videos only appear automatically with iCloud for Windows 14 or later.Your photos and videos appear as thumbnails until you download them.On your Windows computer, open File Explorer, then click iCloud Photos in the Navigation pane.If you don't see iCloud Photos, click Pictures in the Navigation pane, then double-click iCloud Photos.Double-click a thumbnail to download and view it.Icons next to a photo or video's filename indicate its download status and whether it's part of your iCloud Shared Photo Library. See View your iCloud Shared Photo Library on iCloud.com.You can have your photos take up the full browser window, so you aren't distracted by the sidebar or toolbars.Go to icloud.com/photos, then sign in to your Apple Account (if necessary).Double-click the thumbnail of a photo, then click .To move between photos or videos, do any of the following:Press the arrow keys on your keyboard.Hold the pointer over the left or right side of a photo, then click the arrow that appears.Hold the pointer over the top of a photo, click in the top-left corner, then click a thumbnail at the bottom of the window to jump to that photo.To exit this view, hold the pointer over the top of a photo, then click .You can view the thumbnails of your photos and videos as squares (which eliminates the empty space between them) or in their original aspect ratio (which shows the entire image).Go to icloud.com/photos, then sign in to your Apple Account (if necessary).Do one of the following:View your images as squares: Click .View your images in their original aspect ratio: Click .The Photos app recognizes significant people, places, and events in your library, and presents them in curated collections called Memories.Go to icloud.com/photos, then sign in to your Apple Account (if necessary).Click Memories in the sidebar.If you don't see the sidebar, click .At the top, choose Memories or Favorite Memories.Note: If you don't see any memories, try opening them on your device first. Tap the toggle for "iCloud Photos" to enable the feature. So you need to manage your iCloud storage effectively. How to access iCloud photos on an iPhone or iPad 1. If you're using Windows 10, open File Explorer and click on iCloud Photos from the navigation pane on the left. Open the iCloud website (visit) in your preferred browser. The license may not give you all of the permissions necessary for your intended use. Open the "Photos" app on your Mac. With iCloud for Windows, you can view photos and videos stored in iCloud Photos. To start playing again, click View the memory full screen: Click in the bottom-left corner. Next, click the "Options" button next to Photos. After that, click the "Apply" button. See a list of icons and what they mean.After you download your photos and videos, you can view them in the Microsoft Photos app.On your Windows computer, open Cloud for Windows.Below iCloud Photos, click View in Microsoft Photos.Note: In iCloud for Windows 14.2 or later, if you move or delete a photo in the Microsoft Photos app, the same thing happens on all your devices that have iCloud Photos turned on.If you edit a photo or video on your Windows computer, those edits don't appear on your Apple devices or on iCloud.com. The first and foremost thing for accessing iCloud Photos on your iPhone is to ensure that iCloud Photos is enabled on your iOS device. In the Microsoft Photos app, move to the "iCloud Photos" tab on your Windows PC. Here is how it works: 1. While you don't need to install any additional apps to access iCloud Photos on Apple devices, it is not the same case on Windows PCs. On Windows, you first need to install the iCloud app from the Microsoft Store to access iCloud Photos. That means you can take a photo on your phone and see it minutes later on your iPad or the iCloud website. Thanks for your feedback.
