keep playing again These are definitely problems. This game seems to be scripted too. Every time an RTTS pitches, gets zero run support. Going 0-4 on 4 hits at over 100mph. Perfect swings for 112 mph outs. Also the AI management is messed up, my AAA teammate at Iowa Cubs is LHP Justin Steele. Been there all season, has ERA around 2.00, is the acc of the Cubs the past 2 seasons. But not good enough (rating 80+) to make the big leagues in 2025. This game is straight garbage. players even though yes they didn't make a lot of money on the game because it was essentially freeloading it meant that people like me who have 12 different copies of them I'll be the show sitting in their room across PS3 and Xbox One it just gets to a point where if they're going to use the same exact graphic engine not change anything about the
game and release it on the switch that can literally be described as potato graphic why is it fair that we'd be in a position where we can't play the game because they know that there are people like me who use the switch as their main console and I hate to say it but it literally looks like shovelware on the switch. The Series S pushes
the game at around 720-1080p, 60 FPS, and the Switch struggles to maintain 30 FPS—on a mobile chip with 4GB of RAM. But somehow it's "too much" for PC? Come on. I'm running a 5700 XT, which outperforms the GPU in the Series S, and I play all my games at 1080p, 144 FPS without breaking a sweat. The only reason I haven't upgraded my
GPU is because I don't need to. I'm not chasing ultra settings in the latest AAA titles—I care about consistent performance and value. Why would I spend \$500+ on a locked-down console just to play one game that runs worse than it would on my current setup? Let's also not forget: On PC, I don't need to pay a monthly subscription just to access
online play. I'm not stuck in a clunky UI, navigating a proprietary app store just to launch Netflix. I'm not locked into Sony or Microsoft's ecosystem with all their hoops and restrictions. When I buy a game on PC, it's mine—no subscription required, no expiration date. If Sony actually gave PC players a real way to play MLB The Show—and disabled crossplay if cheating's their excuse—you'd see a dedicated, competitive player base form overnight. But instead, they're using this game to artificially prop up a console market that's been stagnant for years. So don't act like I'm out of touch just because I chose a platform that gives me more power, more freedom, and better value. I'm not broke—I'm
just not getting played. @PriorFir4383355 XBL I get where you're coming from, but let's be real here—this isn't about what hardware was available in 2013 or 2017, it's about what's available now and how companies choose to use it. You said it yourself: Switch runs a completely different version of MLB The Show, stripped down and optimized for a
mobile chip with 4GB of RAM. Meanwhile, the Xbox Series S runs it at 60 FPS with GPU performance comparable to a Radeon 5600 XT—not exactly cutting-edge anymore. I have a 5700 XT, which outperforms the Series S GPU. And that's in a PC that doesn't require a subscription to access multiplayer, doesn't limit me to a proprietary storefront, and lets me keep the games I buy forever—not just for the life of a subscription. If the Switch can run its own cut-down version, and the Series S can push out a stable 60 FPS, then PC—especially mid-range setups from the last 5 years—can absolutely handle it. The only reason MLB The Show isn't on PC is because of business decisions, not technical
limitations. And let's talk price: Xbox One (ancient hardware) still sells for a relative price due to nostalgia. Series X/S range from \$284 to \$574. Meanwhile, I already own my PC. The only reason I haven't upgraded further is because I don't need to. My games run at 1080p 144 FPS, I can mod or tweak them freely, and I'm not paying Sony or
Microsoft for the "privilege" of using my own hardware. PC gaming isn't unfriendly to consumers—it's one of the last places where you aren't locked behind walls.
