I guess it depends on how long those video streams are, and which video codec (H.264, VP9, etc.) you use. Another reason for recommending newer processors is that encoder software like x264 have notable performance gains when using AVX2 instructions, which are found in Haswell and newer CPUs. Skip the i7 dual-core as it won't give a noticeable performance increase from your current processor. The 200MHz clock speed difference between the i7-2620M and i5-2520M is just 8%. Last year, I got a barebones (no RAM and HDD) HP Elitedesk 800 G1 SFF with a quad-core i5-4570 for around 60\$. Already had DDR3 RAM and HDD so it wasn't an issue. It's around twice as fast as my X220 (which has a dual-core i7) when encoding videos. TL;DR: I'm trying to dissuade you from undertaking an upgrade that may very well roast your T420, and waste your time and money.
