Effective 1 January 2012, the jurisdiction of all new appointed public notaries extends to any county of the State and will not be limited to the counties of their residence. Code of Alabama § 36-20-70(a). The existing public notaries before 1 January 2012 continue to work in accordance with their existing authorities for the rest of their existing commission. Alabama Code § 36-20-70(b). How to Become a Public Notebook: Prerequisite: You must be a resident of Lee County, Alabama, to run for Lee County. Step 1: Public application full note (Download). Step 2: Take the application to an insurance company to get a Public Note Bond in amount of \$25,000.00. Step 3: Bring or submit the application, the note title and \$36.00 tax to the office of the Probate Judge. (Bond must be signed by the applicant before a public notary before arrival.) If you send a question by mail, please include a car envelope, stamped so that our office can return registered documents. Step 4: The application and the link will be recorded by the Office of Probate Judge. A report of your appointment will also be presented to the Secretary of State of Alabama. A public notary certificate will be issued indicating the date of the notary's commission and the expiry date. Step 5: Notary is responsible for the acquisition of its notary seal or stamp. To authenticate the official acts of the notary, each notary must provide a seal or a stamp. The impression of this seal or stamp must provide the name, office and state for which he was appointed. Code of Alabama § 36-20-72. What can an accused PUBLIC NOTICE do? You can administer the oaths in all the incident issues at the exercise of their office. Take the recognition or proof of writing tools related to trade or navigation and certify the same and all other of their official acts under their office seal. Request for acceptance and payment of exchange bills, known promissory, and all other writings that are governed by the commercial law regarding the days of grace, request, and notice of non-payment and protest the same for non-acceptance or non-payment and to give notice as required by law. To exercise such other powers, according to commercial use or the laws of this state, as may belong to public notaries. Code of Alabama § 36-20-73. What does it feel like to make a COLLECT NOTE for services? The public notaries are entitled to the sum of five dollars (\$5) for the execution of one of the above listed skills. Code of Alabama §What is the PENALTY PERFORMANCE ACTIVITY NOTE WITHOUT A COMMISSION OR an EXPERIENCE COMMISSION? If a person performs a notary act without being a notary or after their commission has expired, they are guilty of a C classand subject to recruitment for no more than three months and/or a fine not exceeding \$500.00. Code of Alabama § 36-20-75, 13A-5-7, 13A-5-12.IS A PUBLIC SUBECT REMOVAL AND IMPEACHMENTATIONAL? Yeah. A notary can be impeached and removed from the office by will to neglect of duty, office corruption, incompetence, excessive use of liqueurs or drugs to such extent in view of the dignity of the office and the importance of its duties makes the notary unsuitable to carry out the duties of the office, or commits any offence involving moral turpitude. Code of Alabama § 36-11-1. What action should I take if I want to redeem my Council COMMISSION? If none of your personal information has changed, you can renew by bringing an updated bond and the \$36.00 fee to the inheritance office or before the expiration date of your commission. If your note commission has expired, you must complete a new application, provide an updated bond, and the fee of \$36.00. What should I do if I change my legal name and my Commission is not exorbitant? You will be required to complete a new application, provide an updated bond, and a new fee of \$36.00 to be commissioned in your new name. Get and complete a question from your County Clerk's office. Find your County Clerk contact information here. Send full question to your County Clerk with \$12 request fee (\$7 for County Clerk and \$5 for Secretary of State). Being elected by the county's legislative body (accounts commission) in the county where the applicant resides or maintains its main place of activity at the time of its election. Protect a secure bond. Bonds are available through the Tennessee insurance companies / agencies that sell security cover. Provide proof of the bond to County Clerk. Your documents will be submitted to the state. The Secretary of State's office will issue the Notary Commission and return it to the County Clerk office for you to retire. Get the note seal. Your Clerk County might be able to assist you. How can I renew a Notary Commission? The renewal process for a notary is the same process of getting your original commission. What is a notary? A notary is a position created by state law that allowsindividuals, as state public officials, of: Recognize signatures on personal knowledge or satisfactory proof Administrative judgments Record and/or transcribe the deposits Confirm the authenticity of signatures on affidavits. What are the duties/ responsibilities of a notary? A notary haspower to administer oaths and take deposits, affidavits, and awards. The powers and duties of a notary can be exercised in all counties of the State of Tennessee. Should the "line book" be a specific format? The Attorney General stated that the notary is not required to maintain the record in a particular type of "well-linked book", but that the notary can keep the information in another registered format, until certain standards are satisfied, as fully established in the opinion. The opinion of the Attorney General is available here: Prosecutor General Opinion No 14-89 What tax can a note fee for their services? According to Tenn. Ann. Code § 8-21-1201, "Publics are entitled to request and receive reasonable taxes and compensation for notable public services." How do I manage a complaint about the conduct of a notary? As for the criminal conduct of a notary, the Attorney General Parere n. 07-157 states: "Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 8-7-103, the District Attorney General has the duty to pursue all violations of state criminal statutes occurring in his district. This obligation includes the prosecution of criminal acts committed by the notaries. A citizen wishing to file a criminal complaint against a notary public can do so by contacting the district attorney general of the judicial district where the alleged criminal behavior occurred and proceeding through the prosecution." In addition, as explained in the previous opinion of the Attorney General, a notary can be removed from the office through the ouster procedure provided in Tenn. Code Ann. § 8-17-101. A directory of district attorneys can be found at the general directory of Tennessee District Attorney. How long does a notary Commission last? A notary's warrant is four years old. The term of four years begins on the date when the notary commission is issued by the governor. It is a Class C error for a notary to act in an official capacity after the expiry of their notary commission. Can I mention my groom's signature? In 2010, the Attorney General's office gave its opinion on the Notarization of the Spouse Signature. 2010 Opinion 10-97: Notarization of the signature of Spouse is a notary a state or official of the county? The notaries are state officials. Advocate General Opinion on whether public notaries are state or county officials. How do you become a public notary? A candidate must fill out an application with the probate judge. The succession judge appoints and commissions all public notaries. How long does a notary board last? Each notary may hold office for a period of 4 years; However, the notary may request a renewal after the expiry of the four-year term. Should a notary be tied? Yeah. A bond of 25,000must be obtained and paid in the state of Alabama and conditioned to carry out faithfully the duties of the notary public. The bond must be executed, approved, deposited and registered in the office of the Succession Judgethe notary can assume any duty. Does a notary have to have a seal? Yeah. To authenticate the notary's official acts, every notary must provide a seal. The impression of this seal must provide the name, office, state and county where the notary was appointed. NOTE FOR STATE AT LARGE Can you become a notary for the whole state? Yeah. You can request an appointment with the court of succession for a notary at the state level. The notary is not limited to any county, but can perform official acts in any county of the state. How long does a commission as a notary last for the state in general? The term of office is the same for a notary at the state level as it is for a notary for a specific county. 4 years. Is a bond necessary for a notary at the state level? Yeah. The state notary must give a bond approved by the court of succession of the county of residence in the amount of \$25,000, payable to the State of Alabama and conditional on faithfully performing the duties of the public notary. The bond must be executed, approved, deposited and registered in the office of the court of succession of the county of their residence before the notary takes on any duties. Do you need to get a seal for a notary at the state level? Yeah. To authenticate the official acts of the notary at the state level, every notary must provide a seal. The impression of this seal must provide the name, office and state in which the notary was appointed. APPLICABLE TO ALL PUBLICS How much must the court of succession be paid to become a public notary? The standard fee collected by the court of succession under the Alabama code is \$31.00, however, the fee may be increased by local law. What can a duly appointed notary public do? A notary may administer oaths, take evidence of instruments of writing relating to commerce or navigation and certify the same and all other of their official acts under their seal of office, demand the acceptance and payment of bills of exchange, promissory notes and all other writings which are regulated by commercial law with respect to days of grace, request and notice of non-payment and protest the same for non-acceptance or non-payment and non-payment required by law. What fees can a notary collect for services? A notary is entitled to the following fees: \$1.50 plus shipping for all services rendered in connection with the protest of any exchange invoice for acceptance, or of any exchange invoice, promissory note, check or other deed for payment \$5.00 for any oath, certificate or seal taken \$5.00 to give any other certificate and app Office Seal \$.20 for every 100 words to give copies from the notarial register \$.25 for each record of each copy Does a public notary have to keep records of every notarial deed? Yeah. Every notary must keep a register of all notarial acts performed. Such register must be given to the county court of succession upon death, resignation, removal or expiration of the period. What it should be with the register of the notary acts once the notary is no longer in office? At the time of death, resignation, removal or expiry of the notary's commission, the register must be handed over to the inheritance judge within 30 days. What is the penalty for the failure to provide the notary register to the inheritance judge on request? Any person who, after death, resigns, removal or expiration of the mandate of any public notary, has the register held by the notary, refuses, on request, to hand over the register to the Succession Judge must, on conviction, be fined no less than \$100.00. What is the penalty for the execution of a notary act without a committee or a committee expired? If a person performs a notary act without being a notary or after their commission has expired, they are guilty of an error and subject to imprisonment for no more than a year. Is a public notary subject to impeachment and removal from the office? Yeah.
