After that, a blue light will start flashing, and the earbuds will turn on automatically Step 2: Turn on Bluetooth on the desired device. Step 3: Go to the device's Bluetooth settings. Step 4: Select "JBL ENDURANCE PEAK II". If a password is needed, type "0000". After that, a blue light will start flashing, and the pairing will be done. Credits: JBL If there is a connection problem, or the connection is lost between the earbuds, then do the following: With the earbuds out of the charging case, press the touch panel on both of them three times. When a blue and red light starts flashing, they will be ready to pair with any device again. Credits: JBL Step 1: Take both earbuds out of the charging case. Step 2: Identify the left and right earbuds. Step 3: Choose the ear tips that best suit your ears. Step 4: Insert the headphones into the inner canal of the ears. Step 5: Rotate for the best possible comfort and best fit, and make sure that the microphone is pointing to the mouth. Turn on. Open the lid of the charging case and take the earbuds out. Credits: JBL To activate or deactivate the mono mode in these earbuds, all you have to do is to pair the earbuds to the device and take out one of the earbuds from the charging case. It will start working by itself. To charge the earbuds, all you have to do is to place them into the charging case and close the lid. The earbuds will start charging automatically. To charge the charging case, all you have to do is to connect the case to a USB charger or charging port with the included USB-A to C cable. It will start charging automatically. To fix this, you can do the following: 1. Try charging the earbud that is not working or both, placing them in the charging case. 2. Try factory resetting the earbuds. 3. Check if the earbuds are operating within a normal working range If that doesn't work, the earbud is probably faulty, and I can go for a refund or replacement of it. If this happens, it may be because the earbuds are dirty or the volume is set low. To fix this, you can do the following: 1. Try cleaning the earbud using a cotton swab or carefully clean the mesh with a pin. 2. Try factory resetting the earbuds. If this happens, it can be because the microphone is muted, or the earbuds are badly positioned. To fix this, you can do the following: If the microphone is muted, check the device microphone volume. If that doesn't work, that means that there might be a defect in the earbud, so try replacing them or get a refund. If the earbuds are earbuds not connecting, it can be because the Bluetooth on the computer has a pairing problem. To fix this, you can do the following: 1. Try disabling Bluetooth from nearby devices >>> then activate the pairing mode of the earbuds, pair and connect earbuds from Settings >>> Bluetooth & other devices >>> Add a new device >>>> select Bluetooth. 2. Try uninstalling and reinstalling the Bluetooth driver, or updating the Bluetooth driver. All can be done in Manage >>> Device Manager, reset earbuds (if available), and then repeat the step. 3.
