The novel is about a London lawyer, Gabriel John Utterson, who investigates the strange relationship between his old friend, Dr. Henry Jekyll, and Jekyll's alter ego, Edward Hyde. According to a source, the work is generally associated with an uncommon mental illness sometimes known as "double personality," where at least two distinct personalities exist within the same person. In this case, the two personalities in Dr. Jekyll reflect good and evil, with completely opposite moral levels. This story had such an impact on our culture and language that when we see people behaving one way and then suddenly another, we sometimes say they're like Jekyll and Hyde. Stevenson's story is based on fiction, but it develops the problem of a double personality. It has even become part of our language. Of course, most people don't reach the level of psychological dysfunction as in Jekyll-Hyde, but reality sometimes imitates fiction in some way. In this case, the spirit of double-mindedness mentioned in the Bible is similar to Jekyll and Hyde in the life of a believer. The spirit of double-mindedness is a real problem in our society, which Jesus can heal and liberate. This is associated with the psychotic disorder known as schizophrenia, where a person's mind and personality become so fragmented and tormented by delusions and instability that they are eventually unable to function in society. Schizophrenia is sometimes associated with double personality or identity. The term "schizo" means to divide, cut off, split, or break apart. Severe schizophrenia is treated by psychiatry with medication. As seen through the history, treatments have been used up to electroshocks to treat hallucinations and delusions (dementia and mental illness). There are different degrees of schizophrenia, but most do not require hospitalization. While there are various definitions of schizophrenia from a psychiatric and medical standpoint, I give the biblical definition according to James 1:8. No one would consider the idea that they could be schizophrenic. Psychology uses the term "alter ego" (from Latin, meaning another self) to refer to a second self, which is believed to be distinct from a person's normal or original personality. The term was coined in the 19th century when dissociative identity disorder was first described by psychologists. A person with an alter ego is said to lead a double life. These alternate personalities are referred to as alters. Personally, I believe what psychology calls alters are simply demons. Remember, demons have personalities. The dual nature has a psychological, spiritual, emotional, and cognitive impact on the mind. Psychologists and psychiatrists approach it as a mental disorder, while liberation ministers see it as a spiritual disorder that must be treated through liberation. The Bible agrees that someone with a divided mind has a mental illness. "The double-minded man is inconsistent in all his ways" (James 1:8), affirms Dr. Pat Holliday. Most people with a double mind adapt to coexist and have some success; however, they still have the characteristics of a spirit of schizophrenia. This causes instability in every area: lack of peace about who they are, what they can or have achieved. Not everyone can go to a psychiatric institution that the world diagnoses as schizophrenia. This revelation about the double mind and schizophrenia occurred during Frank and Ida Mae Hammond's ministry, pioneers in the field of liberation and authors of the classic book on liberation, "Hogs in the House." I had the privilege of ministering with Frank Hammond, a humble and gentle servant of the Lord. Before his passing, I asked him to lay his hands on me, and I believe he imparted his passion for teaching about this subject and seeing people set free. THE NATURAL DIABOLICAL NATURE OF THE DOUBLE-MINDED SPIRIT Then, who is affected by the double-minded spirit? How many are there? Frank and Ida Mae Hammond understood the double-minded spirit as Satan's master plan to destroy humanity. They experienced that almost all people who come to us for liberation have various degrees of demonic spirits that cause schizophrenia. Ida Mae claims that schizophrenia [or double mind] constitutes a disturbance, distortion, or disintegration of personality development. Some teach that Christians cannot have a spirit of schizophrenia, but note that when James said the double-minded man is inconsistent in all his ways (James 1:8), he was addressing saints. Extraction from Barnes' Notes on the Bible [Albert Barnes' Bible Notes]: A double-minded person (here using the Greek term dipsuchos) means someone who has two souls; also someone who is vacillating or inconsistent. It applies to a person who does not have established principles; who are controlled by passions; who... Esta persona claudica entre dos pensamientos y está indecisa sobre qué hacer o decir. No es sincera ni justa en sus pedidos, y puede pide una cosa y significar otra. Por otro lado, la estabilidad es el opuesto de esto. Se refiere a ser firme, estable y constante, sin cambios o fluctuaciones. Dios es un ejemplo de estabilidad, ya que es siempre el mismo ayer, hoy y siempre. No es inconstante ni impredecible, sino confiable y coherente. El propósito de Dios es que tengamos una personalidad estable y no suframos de personalidades múltiples. Debemos ser firmes y constantes, como lo dice la Biblia (1 Co 15:58). No debemos ser como una pelota de ping-pong ni un yoyo, sino ser personas inconstantes. Dios nos creó para destacarnos en la vida y necesitamos estabilidad para sobresalir. El enemigo quiere causar confusión y vacilación, para que no podamos recibir de Dios ni de otros. Sin fe es imposible agradar a Dios, y sin purificación del corazón, el doble ánimo nos divide en dos personalidades. Esto hace que la fe sea ineficaz y la inestabilidad nos sacude. El Salmo 119:113 dice que aborrecemos al hipócrita pero amamos la ley de Dios. El Comentario exegetico de Jamieson, Fausset y Brown define el doble ánimo como personas inconstantes, hombres divididos con una mente dubitativa. El espíritu de doble ánimo se caracteriza por rechazo y rebeldía, y se forma sobre una raíz de amargura. Estas fortalezas interaccionan como un cordón de tres dobleces difíciles de romper. El rechazo es la entrada al espíritu de doble ánimo, que hace prácticamente imposible convertirse en la persona que Dios dispuso. La amargura se ha convertido en un estado habitual de la vida, donde las personas y las circunstancias nos causan heridas y traumas sin cesar. El espíritu de doble ánimo es una fuerza peligrosa que nos hace cambiar entre personalidades falsas y demoníacas, como si fuéramos bolas de ping-pong. Esto nos lleva a un estado constante de inestabilidad, donde nuestras personalidades de rechazo y rebeldía se alternan sin cesar. Este espíritu es común para todos nosotros, y sin la liberación de Dios, lo enfrentaremos de manera recurrente. Vivimos en un mundo inconstante, lleno de personas, familias e instituciones que cambian constantemente, y si no tenemos una personalidad estable y firme en Dios, seremos como una tormenta dentro de otra. La solución a este problema es la liberación y el desarrollo de una identidad santa, que nos permitirá vivir en armonía con Dios en un mundo caótico. Esto es el resultado del espíritu de doble ánimo, que nos hace alternar entre dos personalidades falsas y demoníacas. La frase griega para doble ánimo significa literalmente "dos almas", lo que refleja la dualidad de nuestra personalidad en constante cambio. El doble ánimo puede llevar a una vida de confusión y malas relaciones. La falta de estabilidad y inconstancia pueden afectar negativamente las relaciones conyugales, que son la base de muchos divorcios. Además, esta inestabilidad también puede impactar en las familias y los niños, quienes necesitan un hogar y padres estables para crecer. En el ámbito espiritual, el doble ánimo puede afectar la relación con Dios y llevar a una vida de codicia y envidia, lo que impide alcanzar la paz interior. La guerra interno entre las pasiones y los deseos puede llevar a una vida de lucha y frustración, sin lograr lo que se busca.
