Payout masters 2024

Clark believes this would lead to more exciting matches and ultimately benefit the sport as a whole. Scottie Scheffler wins Masters, solidifying his spot as number one player in the world with a record-breaking \$3.6 million prize. Ludvig Aberg takes home \$2.16 million as consolation after finishing second. Tommy Fleetwood, Max Homa, and Collin Morikawa all earn six figures for their top three finish. The Masters payouts continue to increase, with Scheffler's win setting a new record for the highest winner's share in 2024. Aberg's \$2.16 million prize is also one of the largest paydays for a runner-up at the tournament. Other notable earners include Cameron Smith and Bryson DeChambeau, who both take home \$695,000 for their top six finishes. Xander Schauffele earns \$620,000 for his eighth-place finish, while Will Zalatoris, Tyrrell Hatton, and Cameron Young all receive \$540,000 for tying in ninth place. The bottom third of the leaderboard sees players earning smaller payouts, with Taylor Moore and Lucas Glover both taking home \$250,000 for their top 20 finishes. Further down, Keegan Bradley, Min Woo Lee, and Harris English all earn \$175,500 for their top 22 spots. The Masters Tournament purse for 2024 has been set at \$20 million, a \$2 million increase from last year's amount, representing a 25% bump from two years ago when the purse was at \$15 million. The 2023 Masters purse was the largest of the four major tournaments at that time but is now tied with the U.S. Open for its total in June. The Players Championship remains the biggest fish among PGA Tour events when it comes to payouts, with this year's purse being \$25 million. Winner Scottie Scheffler takes home a share of the \$20 million purse at the Masters. His win also earned him 100 Official World Golf Ranking points and 750 FedEx Cup points. The event saw 60 players finish after a 36-hole cut, with Neal Shipley being the only amateur to make the cut but earn no prize money.
